Old Asa Wyman

Asa Wyman is thought to have been the oldest man ever to live in town. According to Vital Records, Townsend, Mass., he was born in 1750. He died in Athens, Vt., Oct. 11, 1860 aged 110 years. His wife, Jane of Shirley, Mass., was an Indian woman, possessing a violent temper, as told by her great granddaughter Blanche Wyman Powell of Townsend, Mass. Jane also had red hair, a fact which, coupled with her quick temper led to the belief that she was part Irish! Many local people are descended from Asa and Jane.

Genealogies of Athens Families

In the following records of Athens families, it has been the aim of the compiler to include as many of the early settlers as possible, beginning with the first of the name who came to Athens. Where possible, the lineage has been traced back to the emigrant ancestor, the male line given in brackets immediately following the name. The system of numbers gives the superior numeral "1" to the emigrant, and the later generations are numbered from him. Where the emigrant is unknown, the first who came to town is given the superior number "1" at the upper right.

The plan of numbering used by the New England Genealogical Society has been followed as closely as possible.

Families living in Athens four generations or more are included for, although few people residing in town today bear the name of the families listed below, many are descendants of one, and some of several of them.
